**FIFTH YEAR OF FUN AT KINDERHALLE WILL INCLUDE  
DINOSAUR GEORGE AND INTERACTIVE MAGIC**

A full slate of historical, magical and sporting entertainment takes place at this year's fifth year of fun at the Kinderhalle at Wurstfest 2011. The Wurstfest Association, in partnership with the New Braunfels Parks and Recreation Department, will present Kinderhalle family entertainment at the Landa Recreation Center on certain nights during Wurstfest, which takes place Nov. 4-13 along the banks of the Comal River in Landa Park in New Braunfels.

Kinderhalle, located in the Landa Recreation Center on the Wurstfest grounds, offers two Kids Nite Outs on both Saturdays of Wurstfest as well as several family entertainment events throughout the family festival.

"There is no cost for any of the performances, and we aren't taking registration," said Erin Flores, recreation programs supervisor, City of New Braunfels Parks and Recreation Department. "It's more of a drop-in/walk thru, and we'll be having the performances regardless of how many folks show up."

Children must attend performances with an adult.

The Kids Nite Out program, however, is separate. It is a child drop-off event which requires pre-registration, and there is a cost involved: It is \$10 per child.

"We request families pre-register by calling (830) 221-4370. We will take registration the day of the event," Flores said.

Parents can enjoy an evening out on the Wurstfest grounds knowing their kids are safe and having a blast. Child drop-off begins at 6 p.m. and pick-up must be by 10 p.m. Participants will enjoy a variety of activities – from arts and crafts to sports and games, and everything in between.
