WURST WAGEN OFFERS RIDES, PARK N RIDE, AND TICKETS TO WURSTFEST

Rockin’ R River Rides, doing business as Wurst Wagen, for several years now has provided shuttle service to our local residents and also Wurstfest visitors staying in our local lodging accommodations.

Wurst Wagen’s new and improved Web site (www.wurstwagen.net) allows this year’s patrons to buy a ride and a ticket to Wurstfest prior to their arrival.

If you’d rather spend your time at Wurstfest instead of waiting to park and buy tickets, then the solution is easy – Wurst Wagen!

Free parking will be offered for the second year at the Comal County Fairgrounds through Wurst Wagen’s Park N Ride services on Friday, Nov. 4 and 11, and Saturdays, Nov. 5 and 12.

Wurst Wagen ride (roundtrip) and Wurstfest ticket (combo) packages are only \$20 each. Wurst Wagen ride only tickets are \$15 each. Kids 12 and younger are free.

Normal hours of operation for the local hotel routes will be from 7 p.m. to midnight Fridays, Nov. 4 and 11, and from 5 p.m. to 1 a.m. Saturdays Nov. 5 and 12. Remember to call for additional services outside of the dates and times above.

“Reservations are not required but highly encouraged, so we can get you in to the grounds to shake those tail feathers,” said Marsha Snider, Rockin’ R River Rides.

Snider said Wurst Wagen also will have an information kiosk set up near Gate #1 at Wurstfest on Fridays and Saturdays for patrons with questions about routes or wanting to schedule a ride.

“And if you decided you had one too many brews or did one too many chicken dances, then head to Gate #1 to the Wurst Wagen kiosk, so we can help get you to where you need to go,” she said.
