WURSTFEST TOUR OFFERS CHANCE TO VISIT BACKROADS OF TUSCANY

There are a few spots left for the summer Wurstfest Italy Tour 2012, “Backroads of Tuscany with the Italian Dolomites.” David Harper will serve as personal tour guide for the trip that takes place June 9-19 and is hosted by Herb Skoog, director of Wurst Relations, and his wife, Claudia.

The trip will include economy class flights to Rome and from Munich and deluxe private motorcoach throughout in Europe, exclusive to the Wurstfest group.
